Red Yucca--\$6.00

Hesperaloe parviflora

This is a "Growers Special" as these 6-Packs are full of seedlings and should grow rapidly when planted in the ground. Hesperaloe, Yucca, Nolina, and dasylirion are genus' that are popularly called "woody lilies". The common name Red Yucca (botanically a Hesperaloe) works just fine for us. Red Yuccas are Texas Natives and are synonymous with xeriscape plants. Very easy to grow. Extremely low water needs. Offsets pups prolifically. Red flowers mean hummingbirds.

4" Pot Specials

Magic Carpet--75¢

Polygonum cuspidatum

Native to the Himalayas. Magic carpet is a good name for this vigorous ground cover. Patterned leaves turn red in full sun. Small pink globe shaped flowers are heaviest in Spring and Fall but can appear in Summer as well. Root hardy and self seeding once established. Easy to grow!

Profusion Fleabane--75¢

Erigeron karvinskianus

This evergreen perennial plant (in our coldest Winters root hardy) we named for its prolific production of small white daisy like flowers from spring to fall. Perfect for any sunny Hill Country location. This perfect border or specimen plant laughs at deer and barely needs water once established.

All Colors Of Lantana--\$2.50

Lantana species and varieties

Lantanas, as a group, are most varied and indispensable for Texas landscapes. The sterile hybrid New Gold Lantana, a Central American native, blooms heavier than any other flower we know. Being sterile it keeps trying to set seed, but can't. Purple Trailing Lantana is from Argentina and stands up to our coldest winters. Our native Texas Flame Lantana is woody and spiny and can reach 12' tall when searching for light.

Purple Fountain Grass--\$2.50

Pennisetum setaceum 'Rubrum'

Purple Fountain Grass is the most striking of the ornamental grasses with its year round color. Although a Perennial, it's a "tender" perennial and subject to freezing in colder Winters. The good news is it grows super fast and experienced gardeners simply replant it to enjoy its spectacular purple blooms and foliage every year.

Schumacher's Potting Soil

This is the soil we use to pot 1 gallon and larger plants. It is a mixture of aged and new bark. Our potting soil is lightweight with a good workable texture. Also good to amend rocky soils.

Mushroom Compost

The best manure compost we know of. Mix into top 6" of soil or use it as a mulch around plants. This compost has an excellent nutritional content and is even used to grow mushrooms in Gonzales, Texas.

Trial Garden Proven Favorites

Dwarf Barbados Cherry 1 gal \$5.00

Malpighia glabra

A Texas native that blooms in cycles from Spring to Fall. Small orchid like pink flowers are followed by bright red berries both edible and high in Vitamin C. Deer resistant and drought tolerant; it does best planted in garden soil from full sun to full shade. Easy to grow.

Ruby Glow Firecracker Plant 1 gal \$5.00

Russelia coccinea 'Ruby Glow'

A native of Mexico that really likes the heat. Root hardy in our coldest winters. Spectacular both in its unusual form and dazzling clusters of red tubular flowers. Allow it to cascade over rocks or place it in the border as an eye catching specimen plant.

Pink Skullcap 1 gal \$5.00

Scutellaria sufrutescens

Pink Skullcap blooms a deep pink from summer to fall. It forms a tidy mound in sun or shade. It has all the characteristics that have won it a place in virtually every landscape. Texas native. Perennial. Evergreen. Long bloom period. Deer resistant. Drought and soil tolerant. Easy to grow and maintain.
