**Hybrid Gulf Muhly Grass 1 gal Pot--\$2.00
(reg. \$5.00)**

Muhlenbergia capillaris Hybrid
Not the pure bred "Gulf Muhly" found around Houston. This form has been selected for it's "Best Of Show" hands down spectacular performance. Expect large plants to 3' tall with a cloud of purple blooms in Fall that can last for weeks instead of days. This grass, for many of us, is the showiest of them all. It'll make you take another look at Gulf Muhly if you've been disappointed in the past.

Russian Sage 5 gal Pot--\$7.50 (reg. \$12.50)

Perovskia atriplicifolia
Blooms powdery blue spikes to 3' on silver/green foliage all summer till frost. Deciduous but cold hardy throughout the USA. Likes full sun and drainage. Russian Sage is a classic cottage garden or rock garden plant for Texas xeriscapes. Native to W. Pakistan.

Mexican Orchid Tree readily adapts to our Hill Country soils and provides almost continuous

Green Wood Sorrel 4" Pot--75¢ (reg. \$1.50)

Oxalis Regnellii

Deceptively fragile is this root hardy perennial. Native to the southern countries of South America. An estimated 850 species world wide. Its tiny bulblet will rapidly multiply and can be easily divided each year by the ambitious gardener. "Blooming Shamrock"

Bamboo Muhly 4" Pot--75¢ (reg. \$1.50)

Muhlenbergia dumosa

Bamboo Muhly has the graceful visual characteristics of bamboo but is strictly a clump grass. (NOT INVASIVE) A "Winter Grass" that should not be cut back as it greens up and produces seed in March. With a mature size of 5' high and wide, it can be used as a hedge or an accent. Amazingly this "desert dweller grows in the full shade of Cedar trees where almost nothing else will! One of our favorite plants.

Giant Liriope 1 gal Pot--\$2.00 (reg. \$5.00)

Liriope cv. Gigantea

Liriope are all native to the Far East. They make excellent borders and ground covers in a wide range of conditions. Some moisture is preferred. Evergreen with minimal freeze damage and a fairly rapid growth rate from underground rhizomes.

blooms all summer. Surprisingly, it is one of the best butterfly plants in the nursery. One afternoon we identified over 10 different species of butterflies feeding at one time.

Jerusalem Sage 1 gal \$5.00

Phlomis fruticosa

A native of the Mediterranean that performs in Central Texas like a native. The dense gray-green foliage is "Ever Silver" due to pronounced hairiness. Prolific bright yellow flowers and heat tolerance make it a sensation in early Summer. Needs to be used more!

Fall Spider Lilly 1 gal \$7.00

Lycoris radiata

For those who have experience with bulbs, a dormant bulb planted at the right time is always a good deal. This seldom offered antique bulb multiplies in number, value and beauty year after year. Dormant in the heat of summer, flowers emerge magically in Fall. Dark green foliage follows to nourish the bulb through Winter. Offsets prolifically!
